First of all, you need to **create an account**, **verify** the account via your e-mail and **fill in** the online application form. Please save your username and password for future reference. After that procedure, you can login back and fill in your application form.

In order to submit the application, you will also need to upload your signed Learning Agreement and a photo. Please make sure to fill in all the required fields.

When filling in your application, please pay special attention to the dates you are selecting for your mobility, as well as your date of birth because these dates will be displayed on your Erasmus ID card and cannot be changed later. Furthermore, please take into consideration that our office is open for students every day from **Monday** to **Thursday** (except for Fridays). Therefore your arrival and departure should coincide with these dates.
